Teacher's Statement of Faith

Mission Statement: This ministry is under the leadership, guidance, and authority of the Church Elders and Pastors. This ministry will abide by the churches statement of faith, Constitution, and Bylaws. Our Mission is to encourage and support NEBC families in their calling to home educate their children, 2)to encourage excellence and integrity in teaching our children and equipping them for the future, 3)to provide an outreach ministry to other Christian homeschool families in the local area.

Statement of Faith

We Believe:

- 1) The Scriptures, both Old and New Testaments to be the inspired Word of God, without error in the original writings, the complete revelation of His will for the salvation of men and the Divine and final authority for Christian faith and life.
- 2) In one God, Creator of all things, infinitely perfect and eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- 3) That Jesus Christ is true God and true man having been conceived of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He died on the cross a sacrifice for our sins according to the Scriptures. Further, He arose bodily from the dead and ascended into Heaven, where at the right hand of the Majesty on High, He is now our High Priest and Advocate.
- 4) That the ministry of the Holy Spirit is to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ, and during this age to convict men, regenerate the believing sinner, indwell, guide, and instruct and empower the believer for godly living and service.
- 5) That man was created in the image of God but fell into sin and is, therefore, lost and only through regeneration by the Holy Spirit can salvation and spiritual life be obtained.
- 6) That the shed blood of Jesus Christ and His resurrection provide the only ground for justification and salvation for all who believe, and only such as receive Jesus Christ are born of the Holy Spirit, and thus, become children of God.
- 7) That water baptism and the Lord's Supper are ordinances to be observed by the church during the present age. They are, however, not to be regarded as a means of salvation.
- 8) That the true Church is composed of all such persons who through saving faith in Jesus Christ have been regenerated by the Holy Spirit and are united together in the Body of Christ of which He is the Head.
- 9) In the personal pre-millennial and imminent coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and that this "Blessed Hope" has a vital bearing on the personal life and service of the believer
- 10) In the bodily resurrection of the dead; of the believer to everlasting Blessedness and joy with the Lord; of the unbeliever to judgement and everlasting conscious punishment.
