## ""Who Do You Say I Am?""

### Is Jesus Christ the Almighty God?

The topic of this study is the issue of who Jesus is. Some say He is a good man. Others say He is a prophet, and still others say He is the Messiah. All of these are true, but there is one aspect of Jesus that some people are reluctant to admit—is Jesus God? Everything hinges on the answer to this question. If Jesus is NOT God, then He is not a good man—for He lied when He claimed to be God. Furthermore, Christianity would be a hoax without any real value.

For these reasons, the question of Jesus' identity is the most significant question in the world. In Matthew chapter 16, verses 13 through 19, Jesus asked His disciples who people were saying He was. Finally, in verse 15, Jesus directly asked His disciples, "What about you? Who do you say I am?"

Everyone in the world is asked this same question, including you. "Who do you say I am?" Peter answered correctly in verse 16, saying, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God." You must answer this question as well, and your answer is critical—everything hinges on it. If you say that Jesus was merely a good man or a prophet, you've missed Him—and the salvation He offers you. But, if you recognize Jesus for who He is—the Christ, the Son of the Living God—and if you act on this knowledge by making Christ your Lord and Savior, then the salvation Jesus offers is yours.

Nevertheless, many people debate the divinity of Jesus Christ, saying that the Bible does not show Jesus to be God. The truth, however, is that Jesus is God's Son AND God Himself. While this truth may be hard to comprehend, we should remember that God is so much greater than us that we cannot aspire to fully comprehend His majesty and wonder with our finite human minds. God has, however, given us His Word, and the Bible does show, without a doubt, that Jesus Christ is God. Below are a few of the Scripture references which show this. We encourage you to look up, read, and consider all of the following passages.

### God's Word Describes Jesus as God

#### John 1:1

The Word, [Jesus], was God.

#### Colossians 2:9

The fullness of the Deity lives in Christ.

#### Isaiah 9:6

Jesus is referred to as "Mighty God."

#### Isaiah 7:14

The Messiah [Jesus] is to be called "Immanuel," which means, "God with us."

#### Matthew 1:20-23

Again, Jesus was to be called "Immanuel," which means, "God with us."

#### Hebrews 1:3

The Son is the exact representation of God's being.

#### Revelation 7:17

Jesus is in the center of the throne of God.

#### Revelation 22:1, 3

God AND the Lamb (Jesus) share the throne of God

### Jesus Himself Claims to be God

#### Isaiah 48—particularly verses 12-13, 16b

God the Father seems to be speaking in this passage, listing some of His qualities—then says that the Sovereign Lord has sent Him with His Spirit. God sent God with God's Spirit? It is JESUS who has been speaking in this passage! Also an excellent reference to the Trinity.

#### John 10:30

Jesus claims to be one and the same with the Father.

#### John 8:58

Jesus refers to Himself as "I AM," the name God gave Moses for Himself. (Exodus 3:14)

#### John 18:4-6

Again, Jesus refers to Himself as "I AM," this time throwing the soldiers back at the sound of God's name.

#### Revelation 1:8 compared with Revelation 22:12-16

God—the First and the Last—The Almighty, says He is coming soon. Who is coming? God the Father, or Jesus?

### God and Others Describe Jesus as God

#### John 20:28-29

Thomas refers to Jesus as God—Jesus doesn't dispute him.

#### Romans 9:5

Christ is referred to as God over all.

#### Hebrews 1:8

God refers to His Son as God.

### Jesus is Worthy of Divine Worship

#### Matthew 28:9-10

Jesus accepts worship from the women outside the tomb.

#### Hebrews 1:6

God commands His angels to worship Christ.

#### Hebrews 1:10

God refers to Christ as Lord and credits Him with creation.

#### Revelation 4:8-11 compared with Revelation 5:12

Jesus worthy to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise—the same worship given to God the Father.

#### Revelation 5:13-14

Praise, honor, glory and power given to BOTH God the Father and to Jesus.

#### Additional Studies...

There is additional Scriptural proof that Jesus is God as well, and we encourage you to take some time to fully study this in God's Word. God's Word leaves no doubt. Jesus is God.
