## "Father God"

### Our Father Who Art in Heaven...

You've no doubt heard God referred to as our Heavenly Father, but have you thought about what that means? What exactly is a father? A dictionary can define what a father is. Definitions include 'a man in relation to his natural children,' 'a man who has continuous care of children,' 'an important figure in the origin of something,' 'a man provides care and protection,' and 'the oldest and most respected member of a body.'

Which of these definitions apply to God? ALL of them. It is God who is ultimately responsible for our birth. He is our natural Father, providing continuous care, love, instruction and discipline to all of His children. But perhaps the most amazing thing about the concept of God as our Father is the fact that He even WANTS to be our Father. This Family Study is filled with Scripture references which describe God's various Fatherly roles, as well as His holiness and goodness. We encourage you to study these passages with your family this week and get to know God as 'Abba,' Daddy.

### God's Sovereign Holiness and Goodness

The fact that God wants to have a relationship with us is most amazing, especially in light of who He is. More than we can begin to comprehend, God is holy and just, loving and good, almighty and sovereign. Take some time to meditate on that concept as you study these Scriptures.
