## "That's the Spirit!"

### A Wonderful Gift...

Have you ever thought about what an amazing gift it is for someone to have the Spirit of God living within them? Imagine what it must have been like for Jesus' disciples to be in the presence of God. What a life-transforming experience. Yet, we often forget that believers in Jesus Christ ARE in God's presence, because the Holy Spirit dwells within every person who has been saved by Jesus. This study is designed to help you and your family to better understand all the wonderful things the Holy Spirit is to us. We encourage you to go through this study with your family, reading the Scripture passages listed and using the household items mentioned here to help your children to understand and appreciate what an awesome blessing it is to have the Spirit of God with us. As you meditate on Him, may an attitude of heartfelt worship fill your heart, and may God bless you as you seek Him!

### Little Reminders...

Take the items listed below and show them to your family as you read the accompanying Scripture passages.

#### Item #1: Compass or Map (READ John 14:26)

A map or a compass keeps us from getting lost. It guides us in the right direction. The Holy Spirit does the same. He guides us and teaches the way we should live for Jesus.

#### Item #2: Toothbrush (READ John 16:7-8)

A toothbrush can remind us of the Holy Spirit because just as a toothbrush helps us to clean our teeth, the Holy Spirit helps us to clean our lives of sin. Also, brushing your teeth is not always fun, but is necessary to keep our teeth healthy and clean. Being convicted of sin by the Holy Spirit is not fun either, but it is necessary if we are going to live lives for Jesus.

#### Item #3: Teddy Bear (READ John 15:26)

A teddy bear (or stuffed animal) is something we hold to bring us comfort when we are scared or need a friend. The Holy Spirit is called the "Comforter," (or "Counselor") which means He loves us and will comfort us when we are scared or need a friend. He's even better than a teddy bear because the Holy Spirit is always with you to comfort you.

#### Item #4: Packet of Seeds (READ Gal. 5:16,22-23)

The seeds grow into plants. The Holy Spirit helps us to grow in Christ and in wisdom. He helps us grow and grow and grow as long as we are willing to listen to Him.

#### Item #5: A Flower

(READ John 14:25-27)

Flowers remind us of the peace the Holy Spirit gives us. They remind us of peace because people often give flowers to show friendship and love. And, no matter what is going on in the world, flowers continue to bloom and give beauty and peace to the world; just as the Holy Spirit can ALWAYS give us peace, no matter what is happening.

#### Item #6: Magnifying Glass

(READ I Cor. 2:12-13)

Just as a magnifying glass helps us to see things more clearly, the Holy Spirit helps us to see things more clearly. He helps us to recognize good things and bad things. He helps us to recognize and stay away from evil, and helps us to see the good things we should do.

#### Item #7: Small Bible

(READ I Cor. 2:9-10)

The Bible tells us all about the Holy Spirit, but the Holy Spirit helps us to understand the Bible better. He helps us to know what the Bible says and how we should apply it to the situations we are in.

#### Item #8: Cell Phone

(READ Romans 8:26-27)

A phone allows us to talk to others who are far away. The Holy Spirit talks to God for us when we don't know what to pray. Sometimes we are confused and don't know what we need to ask God for, but the Holy Spirit will talk to God the Father for us when we don't know what to say.

## Sowing to Please the Holy Spirit...

### Read Galatians 6:7-10.

This passage provides exhortations to live in such a way as to please the Holy Spirit instead of our sinful nature. Discuss these questions with your family after reading the Galatians passage.

- Q. What do these verses say about our responsibility to listen and obey the Holy Spirit?
- A. We can either obey the Holy Spirit, or we can listen to our sin nature. It is up to us to follow the Holy Spirit.
- Q. Does everyone in the world receive the Holy Spirit? If no, then who does?
- A. No, only those in Christ receive the Holy Spirit.

So the first thing we must do to receive the Holy Spirit is to ask Jesus to save us and give us the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is our friend, our comforter, our convictor, our guide and our helper. Once we have the Holy Spirit, we still have to allow Him to work in our lives. If we don't listen to the Holy Spirit and obey Him, He can't help us as much. So it's up to us to ask for His help and to listen and obey Him.
